Visionary leaders from any field, possessing bold and adventurous ideas, can display their unique talent at this conference. Vision is not seeing things as they are, but as they will be!

We are interested in submissions that are both conceptual and empirically-based research papers, abstract, case studies and work-in-progress. The work should represent the application of various theoretical lenses to explain the relationship between ethical leadership to a global perspective.

Proposals, for papers and posters, are due no later than October 1, 2017

All proposals accepted for presentation will be included in the official program

Presenters should provide their own easel for their poster display

Criteria for selection of proposal include:

- Relevance to the conference theme
- What problem does the proposed paper address?
- What is the research question?
- How are you going to answer your research question?
- Significance of the specific topic to the general audience
- Does the proposed paper (content, design, creativity) contribute to the literature?
