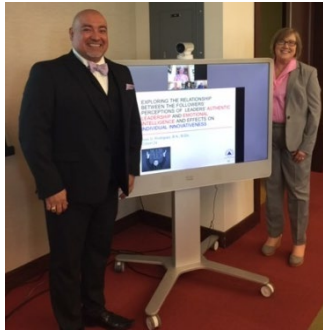

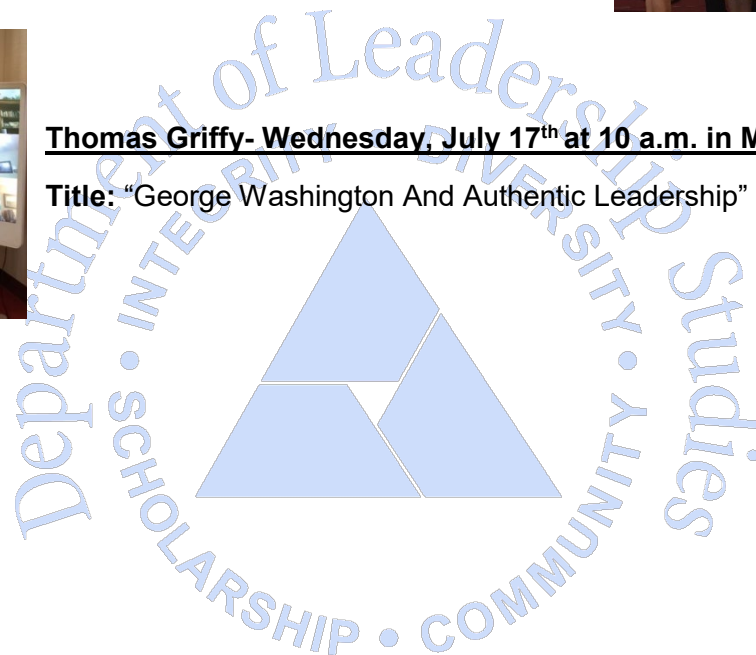

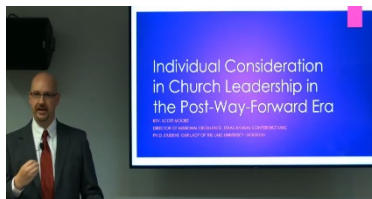


Community Accomplishments

Lydia Hammer, a Ph.D. in our Leadership Studies program has recently traveled to Boston to celebrate the successful completion of the inaugural Leadership Academy, in cooperation with the at the National Conference for the Association of Recovery in Higher Education (ARHE). The following is a summary from the program's highlights, written by Hannah Fitzpatrick:

"Sixty students, representing over 35 campuses from across the country, were accepted into the academic year-long fellowship...As part of the program, students were required to create and implement a project on their campus or community that positively impacted collegiate recovery. With the help of an assigned mentor, the students navigated the trials and triumphs of enacting change on their campuses. Students also received a full scholarship to attend a regional Leadership Summit where they learned about the principals of servant leadership, the importance of the collegiate recovery movement, and time spent connecting with their peers from across the nation."

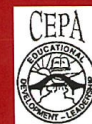

**Presenter: Dr. Bruce Rosenthal, Dean of Our Lady of the Lake University
School of Business and Leadership**



Dr. Rosenthal has a long and varied career that has taken him to Tokyo, the Mediterranean, Philadelphia, and Wall Street in New York.

Fluent in Japanese, Dr. Rosenthal worked for a Japanese automation manufacturer early in his career. After earning an MBA at Rutgers University in International Business, Dr. Rosenthal worked for Merrill Lynch. He was subsequently hired by a division of Dow Jones and was responsible for working with Japanese and non-Japanese clients negotiating multinational deals.

After five years with the Dow Jones Tokyo Office, Dr. Rosenthal moved his family to the Mediterranean where he ran his own business selling designs and artwork in Japan, Southeast Asia and Europe. He moved with his family back to the U.S. where he became the director of the MBA program for the University of the Sciences in Philadelphia, where he also earned his PhD in Health Policy. He has been an academic leader since 2003 and has helped four universities develop new, innovative academic programs. He has been with OLLU since 2018.

Each campus has a campus director and staff who help support the academic programs offered in those locations.

The Houston Campus, located in 600 North Sam Houston Parkway, has proudly served the greater Houston area for over 28 years. We offer undergraduate degree completion in Business (Management and Accounting), Psychology (Pre-counseling and general), Sociology, and an on-line Criminology and Criminal Justice program. We also offer MBA programs in Management and Healthcare Management, an MS-Psychology (Group, Couple and Individual Psychotherapy) program, and will introduce the MA-Sociology in Spring 2015. The very successful Ph.D. in Leadership Studies program is launching its fifth year in Houston this fall.

The Rio Grande Valley

The Rio Grande Valley campus is situated in the center of the Valley, making it easily accessible to people from Rio Grande City all the way to Brownsville. The Lake began offering the Ph.D. in Leadership Studies in the RGV in 2008 and has since expanded the program offerings to include the MS-Organizational Leadership, Master of Social Work-Advanced, Master of Social Work-Foundation, Bachelor of Social Work, BA-Psychology (Pre-Counseling and General), BA-Criminology and Criminal Justice as well as a BA-Multidisciplinary Studies and Research. Currently, there are approximately 160 students enrolled across our programs and our campus offers seven classrooms, a student lounge, multi-purpose room, and two fully equipped computer labs to serve the needs of our students. In the Fall of 2019 the RGV will welcome PhD Cohort 11 and MSOL Cohort 10.

The San Antonio campus offers undergraduate degrees in Business, Computer Information Systems and Security, Healthcare Administration and Management. Master of Business Administration degrees are offered in Finance, Health Care Management and Management.
